The Latin American Association of Magnetism (ALMA) has as its mission the promotion and development of magnetism and magnetic materials in the region, increasing the visibility and impact of research on fundamental and applied magnetism and highlighting its importance in the various branches of physics, technology and in industry. Specifically, ALMA aims to promote several actions, including the organization of the LAW3M.

The LAW3M started in 1991, with its first version in Havana (Cuba). Since then, it has been realized every 2-3 years in Central and South American countries. The LAW3M is an important conference in Latin America, which join students, researchers, and academics devoted to magnetism from around the world, including the participation of renowned scientists in the form of plenary and invited talks. It is a unique opportunity to present the cutting-edge research developed by Latin American researchers to the scientific community.
